Improved documentation

Goal is clear, open and transparent process documentation

Collaboration with stakeholders in developing documents is a key requirement



Improved documentation

“User instructions” on IANA functions being developed

Estimate for publication for public review start of 2013

Will follow ICANN standard process (minimum 42 days)



Improved performance reporting

ICANN will publish improved statistical reporting on processing times

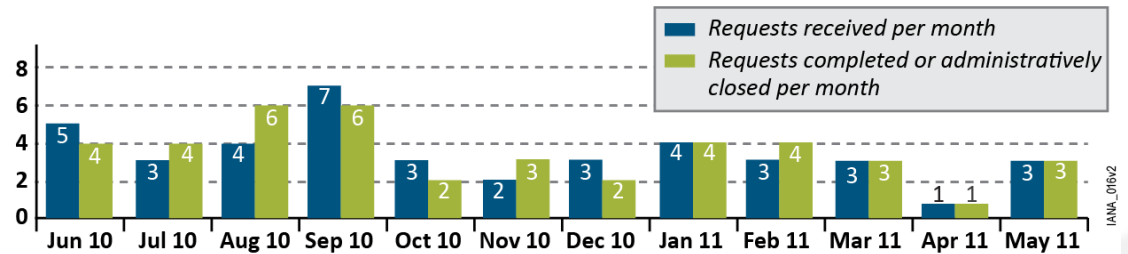
Prototypes were published in our contract proposal, working on refining approach now.

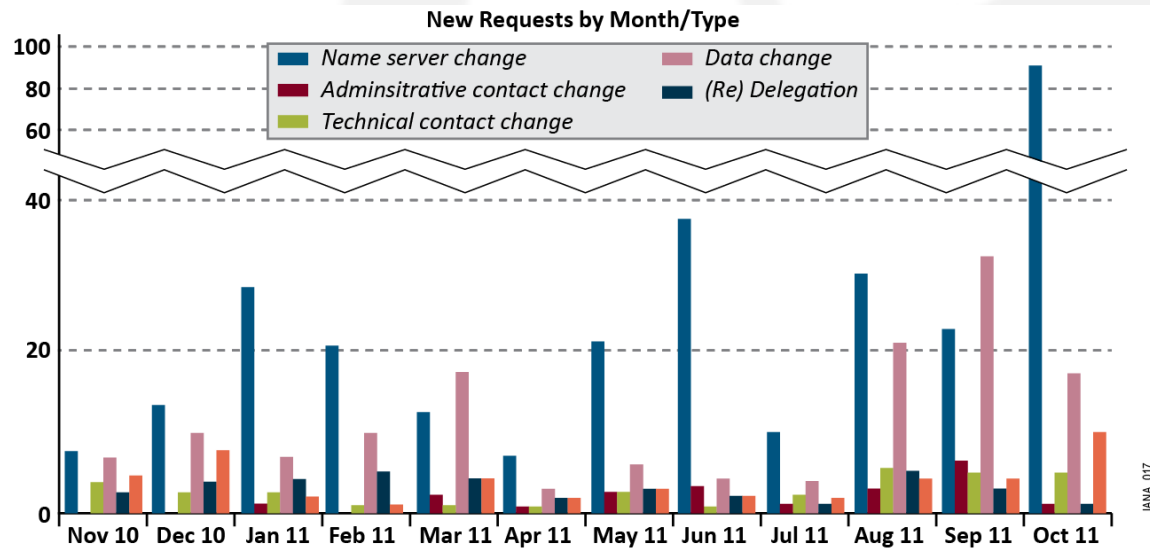

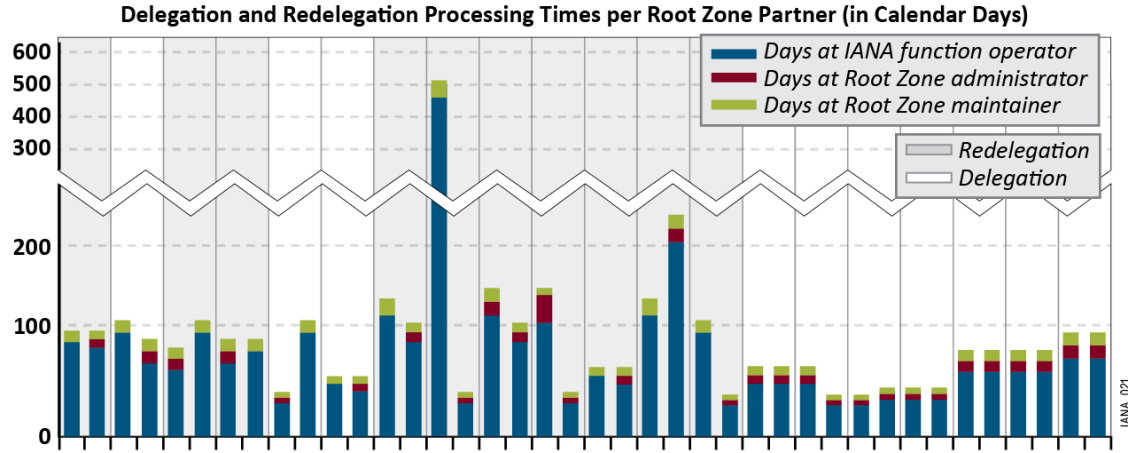

Publication of pending delegation related requests?

Until now, pending requests were first made public on draft Board agendas



Improving our automation systems

First major revision launched mid-2011. Well received.

Next major revision will focus on new gTLD workflow, making a number of refinements we've collected from a year of experience.



New gTLD Workflow



As with previous new gTLD rounds, ICANN approval of new gTLD comes prior to IANA processing.

Applicant eligible to start ICANN process once pre-delegation testing performed and contracted



New gTLD Workflow (2)

Process of hand-off from TAS (new gTLD application system) to IANA being finalised

Goal is to make process as automated as possible. Root zone workflow more akin to “routine” change requests.



Other user interface improvements

Updated web interface, clearer instructions, more robust method of getting contact confirmations

Added 234 DS records to the root zone (and removed 135) up to 30 September 2012



IDN ccTLDs



37 unique requests for country codes in non-Latin scripts

47 strings approved

33 new ccTLDs representing 23 countries (23 languages, 15 scripts)
